**Friday 6 September** From Adelaide - Take midday flight from Adelaide airport to arrive Olympic Dam 1330 - Here you are greeted by your pilot for aircraft transfer to Marree and overnight, arriving approx 4pm. En-route view Andamooka Opal fields, Olympic Dam mine, Dog Fence. Overnight Marree Hotel

Saturday 7 September - Morning flight to Birdsville over Lake Eyre, the Tiari Desert and Lake Eyre National Park. We cross the Cooper Creek, fly over the Goyder lagoon wetlands and follow the Warburton & Diamantina Rivers, viewing large cattle stations to Birdsville. Land in Birdsville approximately 10 am beside the iconic Birdsville Pub, and you are transferred to the famous Birdsville Races and Corporate Marquee for an afternoon of fun, outback atmosphere and a flutter on the horses with gourmet food included. A 3 hour tour to Big Red in the Simpson Desert is available this day if booked. Depart around 5pm for Marree overnight. Alternative option is to join our 4WD guests at our Birdsville safari camp for the night life in Birdsville (including entertainment, dance, movies, street stalls, Birdsville Pub) and fly out next day.

**Sunday 8 September** - Enjoy the sights of Marree including Old Ghan railway history & railway precinct, Afghan Mosque and Cameleers history, Tom Kruse "Outback Mailman" truck and museum, Aboriginal Cultural Centre, Lake Eyre Yacht Club. Flight from Marree to Olympic Dam to catch Qantas flight to Adelaide. Option extra if pre booked to extend flight to William Creek along Old Ghan railway line viewing Mound Springs, Coward Springs, Curdimurka Overland Telegraph Line Station, Lake Eyre South.
